

## **Minnesota County Information Technology Leadership Association Director/Legislative Liaison**

Responsibilities include:

- Providing association management services, including budget management, meeting planning and support, and membership services,
- Providing legislative advocacy,
- Serving as a liaison between state agencies and county IT departments, and
- Conducting background research/analysis of IT/data practices policy issues.

The successful candidate will be a self-starter, have ability to understand and communicate complex subject matter to a variety of audiences, possess the ability to achieve consensus on controversial issues, and have strong organizational skills.

Bachelor's degree plus a minimum of three years applicable experience required. Applicants must be proficient with technology including, but not limited to, Microsoft Office. Overnight travel is required occasionally throughout the state of Minnesota.

AMC offers competitive benefits and positive working environment. Starting salary dependent on qualifications but expected to be between \$60,000 - \$75,000.
